

## **Kent County Council - Temporary Road Closure - Various Roads, New Romney - 16th March 2026 (Folkestone and Hythe District)**

Due to works planned to be undertaken by **Kent County Council**, it will be necessary to close part of Various Roads, New Romney, from 16th March 2026 with estimated completion by 26th March 2026.

Closures are planned in 8 phases as detailed below, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Phase 1 - From 16th March 2026, with estimated completion by 16th March 2026.

Ashford Road will be closed as a rolling closure between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only, once works are completed on one section works will commence on the next.

The road will be closed between the junctions of A259 High Street and North Street & from the junction of Cockreed Lane to outside property Jacaranda.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Ashford Road, Five Vents Lane, A259 Lydd Road, A259 High Street and vice versa.

Phase 2 - From 17th March 2026, with estimated completion by 17th March 2026.

Spitafeld Lane will be closed between the junctions of A259 Lydd Road and Sussex Road, between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A259 Lydd Road, Sussex Road, Spitafeld Lane and vice versa.

Phase 3 - From 18th March 2026, with estimated completion by 18th March 2026.

Sussex Road will be closed between the junctions of A259 Lydd Road and West Street, between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A259 Lydd Road, West Street, Sussex Road and vice versa.

Phase 4 - From 19th March 2026, with estimated completion by 19th March 2026.

St Johns Road will be closed between the junctions of A259 Lydd Road and West Street, between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A259 Lydd Road, West Street, St Johns Road and vice versa.

Phase 5 - From 20th March 2026, with estimated completion by 20th March 2026.

Rome Road will be closed between the junctions of A259 High Street and North Street, between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A259 High Street, Ashford Road, North Street and vice versa.

West Street will be closed from the junction of A259 High Street to outside the car park entrance, between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A259 High Street, Ashford Road, North Street, West Street and vice versa.

Phase 6 - From 23rd March 2026, with estimated completion by 23rd March 2026.

Rolfe Lane will be closed between the junctions of Ashford Road and Craythorne Lane, between the hours of 09:00 and 15:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Ashford Road, Fairfield Road, Craythorne Lane and vice versa.

Phase 7 - From 24th March 2026, with estimated completion by 24th March 2026.

Cockreed Lane will be closed between the junctions of Ashford Road and Pearmain Way, between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Ashford Road, Rolfe Lane, Cockreed Lane and vice versa.

Phase 8 - From 26th March 2026, with estimated completion by 26th March 2026.

St Marys Road will be closed from outside Redcroft to the junction of Cockreed Lane, between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via St Marys Road, School Road, Lane From Junction With Turngate Cottage To Hope Lane, Hope All Saints, Ashford Road, A259 High Street, A259 Dymchurch Road and vice versa.

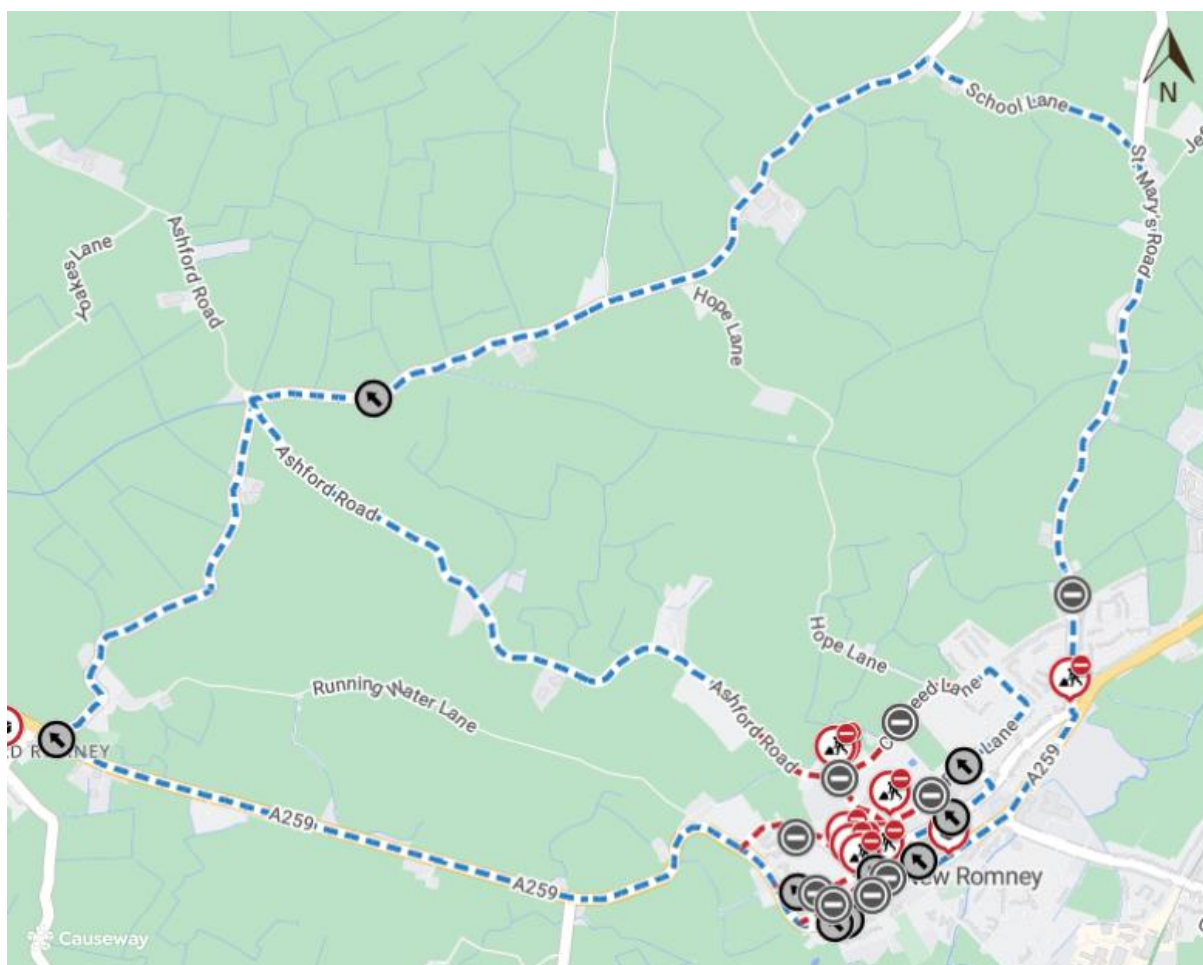
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
