About the role

Lydd Town Council is looking for a dedicated and community-minded individual to help keep our assets looking at their best. We need a reliable Litter Picker to proactively manage the cleanliness of our open spaces –The Rype, Memorial Gardens and The Banks, taking pride in keeping our local environment free of rubbish. In addition there will be cleaning duties at the Guild Hall, Lydd.

Key Responsibilities

- **Litter Collection:** Collect and remove loose litter and debris in areas as above
- **Bin Monitoring:** Checking our litter bins and emptying as required
- **Cleaning** – Of the interior and exterior of the Guild Hall, emptying indoor bins and watering window boxes. Preparing the Council Chamber for meetings. There will be times when outdoor play equipment, benches or noticeboards require cleaning.
- **Reporting:** Notifying the Town Clerk of any environmental issues, such as fly-tipping, vandalism, or damaged play equipment and benches etc

Requirements:

- To be Reliable and able to work independently and safely on your own initiative
- Physically fit and comfortable working outdoors in all weather conditions.
- A driver's licence and access to your own vehicle may be required to travel between various locations in the parish but all areas can be reached on foot.
