Kent resident targeted by banking scam

A resident in Kent was targeted by criminals, claiming there was fraud on their bank account.

What happens:

- You receive a text saying they are from Barclays Bank.
- There appears to be fraud on your bank account.
- Fraudsters will call you, using a Barclays Bank telephone number.
- You are instructed to move your money to another account to keep it safe.
- The caller will tell you which account to transfer your money to.



What to do:

- This is a SCAM banks will never tell you to transfer money into a 'safe account'
- The caller is using 'phone spoofing' this is when scammers change their caller ID to another number.
- Call 159 to speak directly to your banks fraud department.
- Make sure your line is cleared before dialling, or use another phone. The scammer may stay on the line to trick you further.
- Fallen for this scam? Contact your bank immediately.
