

Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd - Temporary Road Closure - King Street, Brookland - 18th October 2025 (Folkestone and Hythe District)

Due to works planned to be undertaken by **Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd**, it will be necessary to close part of King Street, Brookland, from 06:00 18th October 2025 with estimated completion by 00:01 19th October 2025.

King Street, Brookland, will be closed at the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via King Street, Rectory Lane, A259 Rectory Lane Roundabout, A259 Brookland Bypass, A259 Straight Lane, A259 Rhee Wall Roundabout, B2080 Rhee Wall, B2080 Brenzett Corner Roundabout and vice versa.


Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing level crossing works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.
