HIGH STREET, STATION ROAD AND DENNES LANE, LYDD

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that B2075 High Street, B2075 Station Road and Dennes Lane, Lydd has been closed to through traffic, on or after 27th July 2026 for up to 5 days.

The road is closed between the junctions with Harden Road and Park Street (access maintained for residents). A full hard road closure will be between the junctions with Poplar Lane and Oak Lane (no access for traffic).

The alternative route is via Station Road (B2075), Harden Road, Dungeness Road Roundabout, Robin Hood Lane, Tourney Road, Queensway, Park Street and High Street (B2075) .

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
