
So, what have I been up to recently......





ILLEGAL FISHING

Some of you might remember a previous post of mine regarding illegal fishing at the CEMEX Quarry Lydd on Sea. Well, I managed to stop a vehicle and give words of advice to its owner regarding fishing at the quarry, pointing out the dangers due to the depth and coldness of the water and that fishing on a private lake without the owner's permission is actually 'theft of fishing rights'.

There are others who fish at the quarry and hopefully by me speaking to the chap and with these MCV posts that quite often get shared on social media by yourselves, the message should spread to the others that they should cease from fishing there.

SPEEDING

I've been popping up with the speed gun device too although I do appreciate that there are many places across the Marsh where speeding is an issue but I do endeavour to get round to as many as possible and whilst in Ivychurch recently, I stopped a young chap who was driving a car on his own and with no learner plates, ordinarily this would be fine but just having a provisional driving licence it isn't. The law is that if you haven't passed your driving test and are using a provisional licence, you need a person to supervise your driving and they need to be at least 21 years of age, have held a full driving licence for at least 3 years and be qualified to drive the type of vehicle that the provisional licence holder is driving so for example, if the car is a manual then they will need to have a manual licence.

SURGERY MEETING

On Saturday 25th May I held a surgery at Lydd Police Station and was pleased that some of you came along to express what problems are concerning you, speeding came up again and as stated above, I will try and address this at the locations discussed. Another subject that we spoke about was the recreational use of drugs, in particular Cannabis, allegedly being used by people driving to rural locations, parking up and smoking it. 'Drug driving' is a serious matter alongside drink driving and even if you are not smoking Cannabis but one of your passengers is in close proximity to you as the driver, you will very likely inhale enough of it to put you over the drug drive limit and if stopped by the police whatever the reason or you are involved in a Road Traffic Collision whether it's your fault or not, you could be finding yourself being tested at the roadside for the presence of drink (alcohol) or illegal drugs which could lead to a spell in custody and losing your driving licence, I will be paying attention to the areas highlighted to me.

Also, if you would like to discuss something that you'd rather not talk about in front of others, again we can arrange a one-to-one appointment.

COLD CALLERS!

Polite reminder about 'cold callers', if you need any work done to your property whether that be roofing, driveways, gardening, decorating or anything that you would like a tradesperson to do, please don't be tempted to employ someone who just turns up unannounced at your front door even if their quote sounds like the bargain of the century! Please try and use a reputable company who YOU contact and not them contacting you out of the blue. I am still seeing residents who use the services of cold callers and enter into a verbal contract (a definite no no) and agreeing on prices without any written contract and if it is a written contract, please read through it checking what your rights are and only signing it when you are 100% happy with everything in it including the total amount of money that you have agreed to pay. If you use a reputable company and have any questions, they will be happy to answer them, there are plenty of excellent local tradespeople across the Marsh who are well established so why would you use a cold caller

who more often than not do not have a local business address, lesson of the day over! 🥌



EMERGENCY/NON-EMERGENCY ADVICE

Please always remember, if it is a crime in progress then it's 999, if it's a crime or suspicious event and is not an emergency then please report it via the Kent Police website online reporting tool or live chat and 101 as a last resort because this can be very busy but by all means, once you've reported it, you can still let me know via MCV or email.
