3. Any change of status or extension of firing time will be notified giving as much notice as is possible.
4. During firing times Range Control Operators can be contacted on Folkestone 01303 225879 (Hythe) or 01303 225518 or 225500 (Lydd), or by radio on Channel 73, 156.675 MHz. The Range Safety Craft when on station can be contacted on Channel 73 or the emergency Channel 16, 156.800 MHz.
