# 10. KENT MINERALS AND WASTE LOCAL PLAN 2013-20 (THE PLAN) REFRESH

# **Regulation 18 Public Consultation**

The Kent Minerals and Waste Local Plan 2013-30 (KMWLP) was adopted in July 2016 with some limited changes adopted in 2020 as part of the Early Partial Review.

The National Planning Policy Framework (2021) (NPPF) and legislation require that Local Plans should be reviewed to assess whether they require updating at least once every five years. Having been adopted five years ago, the Kent Minerals and Waste Local Plan 2013-30 has been reviewed to assess whether updates to the Plan's Vision, Strategic Objectives, policies and supporting text are required.

The review concluded that while much of the KMWLP is still relevant, some updates are needed in response to relevant Government policy and legislation published since 2016 including the following:

- Updates to the National Planning Policy Framework;
- legislation and policy concerning the need to adapt to, and mitigate, climate change and associated low carbon growth;

- new policy relating to the management of low-level radioactive waste; and,
- policy and legislation concerned with achieving a circular economy where more waste is prevented or reused.

A number of further minor changes are proposed which are intended to improve the clarity of the policies. None of the proposed changes seek a fundamental shift in the way minerals will be supplied and waste will be managed in future.
