(c) Y21/0101/FH – 2 Taylor Road Lydd-on-Sea Kent

Proposal: Sub division of the existing two first floor self-contained flats together with the construction of 3 front and 3 rear dormer windows in the existing roof to form additional four flats within the roof space. Insertion of two lights in the rear roof slope, relocation of existing extractor flue on the rear elevation. Addition of external cladding to first floor front elevation, insertion of new windows to the rear elevation and formation of associated parking area following demolition of existing structures.

Councillor Jones said the existing plans were accepted by the Planning Committee and the new plans are over intensive by making four flats in the roof. Councillor Sweeney said by making the two flats into four could possibly be a fire hazard and the exit routes will need to be addressed.

Councillor Jones said that the flats also overlook existing properties and there is not enough parking for the extra flats.

Councillor Sweeney said that he would propose to reject the application.
